Scoring Instructions:

- Please ensure to fill out the round number (ie. 1,2,3 or Final) and Team names.
- Please also enter which team is batting and which team is bowling
- Speak to a team manager to get batter and bowler names and order
- Enter Batter and Bowler names in their appropriate box
- When run/runs are scored mark down in batters 'Runs Scored' and the appropriate 'ball box' (either ball 1,2 etc) for the bowler
- At the completion of an over total the runs and wickets and enter in the bowlers total
- Extras ie. wides, no balls, byes etc are to added to both the batters score and the bowlers total
- Batting and bowling totals should be added at the completion of the innings and each should match
- Enter total batting scores into box at bottom of sheet.
- Add the amount of wickets taken when the batting team bowled (5 runs per wicket) and total score will result
